### **Is Dominican Center at Marywood used only for religious and Catholic functions?**

Dominican Center welcomes all faith traditions. We host a number of events that are of diverse and interfaith traditions.

### **Is smoking allowed at Dominican Center?**

Dominican Center at Marywood is a non-smoking facility, as are the grounds. Guests who wish to smoke must leave the campus to do so.

### **Is parking available?**

Dominican Center at Marywood has free and accessible parking, which is located off of Lakeside Drive. Lakeside Drive runs along the east side of the campus between Fulton Street and Michigan Street. Please see our maps for more information.

### **Do I have to be participating in a scheduled conference to stay overnight at Dominican Center?**

There are a limited number of overnight rooms here at the center, which are reserved for those participating in personal retreats, or for guests attending functions within Dominican Center. Our overnight space is not open to the public.

### **Is a shuttle service to and from the airport available?**

Dominican Center at Marywood does not provide shuttle service.

### **Is outside food allowed at Dominican Center?**

Dominican Center has a fully staffed and licensed kitchen, headed by a certified executive chef and catering manager. Events requiring food and beverage service must use Dominican Center's catering service. Our diverse menu provides options for all dining needs and events. We are also able to accommodate special dietary needs and restrictions.

Dominican Center does not have a license to serve alcohol.
